2. Attend a service project
3. 6 days and nights of camping
4. Attend a Fall Reunion, Spring Conclave, or the Lodge Banquet
5. Participate in a camp promotion, Elangonat, dance team, or Ordeal team.

The word admonition means counsel, advice, or caution.
