Work Gloves, Loppers, Bow Saws, Rakes, Safety Goggles and Shovels

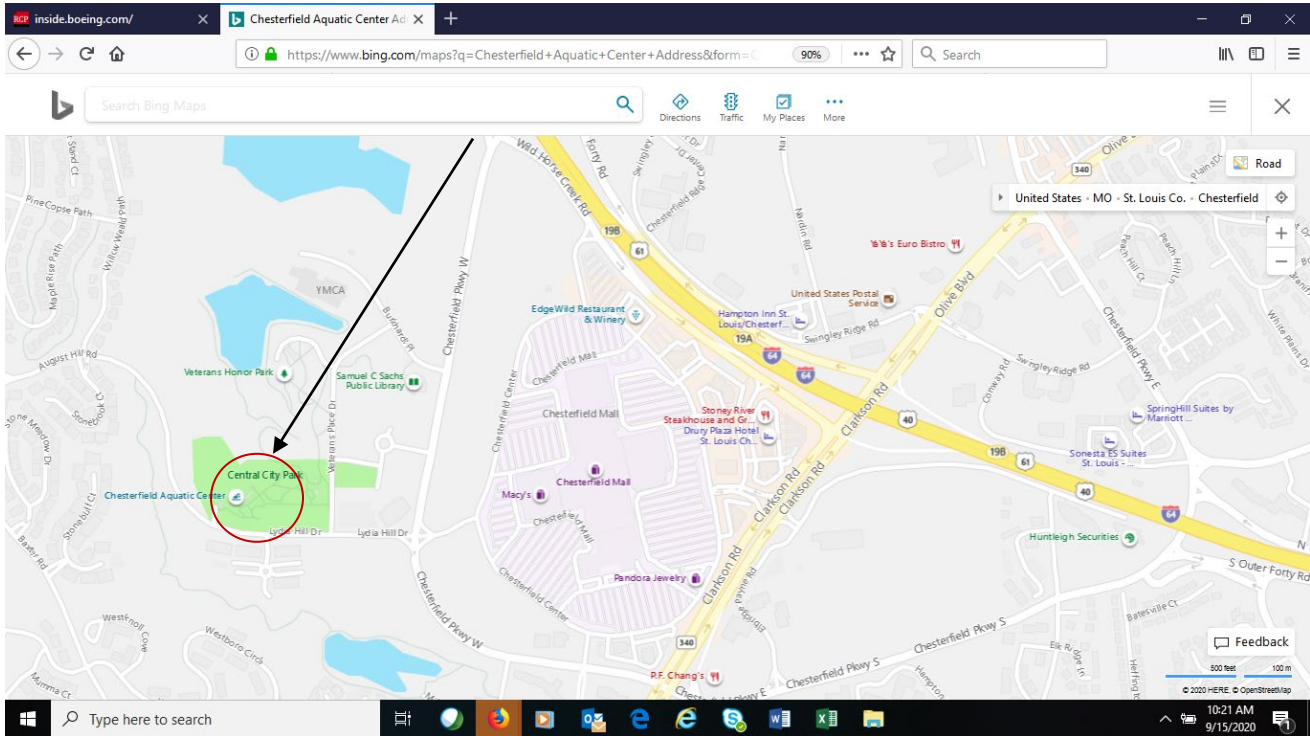
Also please be sure to wear some sort of Class "B" BSA Uniform to promote Scouting!
